



Groves Academy Technology Safety and Use Policy

I. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to set forth policies and guidelines for access to Groves' computer system and acceptable and safe use of the internet, including electronic communication.

II. General Statement of Policy

In making decisions regarding student access to Groves' computer system and the internet, including electronic communications, Groves Academy considers its own stated educational mission, goals, and objectives. Electronic information research skills are now fundamental to the preparation of citizens and future employees. Access to Groves' computer system and to the internet enables students to explore thousands of libraries, databases, bulletin boards, and other resources while exchanging messages with people around the world. Groves expects that its faculty will blend thoughtful use of the school's computer system and the internet throughout the curriculum and will provide guidance and instruction to students in their use.

III. Limited Educational Purpose

Groves provides students with access to its computer system, which includes the internet. The purpose of the system is more specific than providing students with general access to the internet. Groves' system has a limited educational purpose, which includes use of the system for classroom activities and educational research. Students are expected to use electronic media, communication and internet access to further educational and personal goals consistent with the mission of Groves and school policies. Uses which might be acceptable on a user's private personal account on another system may not be acceptable on this limited-purpose network. Use of electronic resources will follow the rules set forth in the Groves Policies and Guidelines (in the Parent Student Handbook) as well as all city, county, state and federal laws.

IV. Use of System is a Privilege

The use of Groves Academy's network, access to, and use of the internet are a privilege, not a right. Depending on the nature and degree of the violation and the number of previous violations, unacceptable use of the school's system or the internet may result in one or more of the following consequences: suspension or cancellation of use or access privileges; parental contact or meeting; payment for damages and/or repairs; discipline under other appropriate Groves policies, including suspension and expulsion; or civil or criminal liability under applicable laws. Each policy violation will be assessed and dealt with at the discretion of Groves Academy administrators, teachers and technology staff.

V. Unacceptable Uses

A. The following uses of Groves' computer system and internet resources or accounts considered unacceptable include but are not limited to:

1. Students will not use the school's system to access, review, upload, download, store, print, post, receive, transmit or distribute:
 - a. pornographic, obscene or sexually explicit material or other visual depictions that are harmful to minors;
 - b. obscene, abusive, profane, lewd, vulgar, rude, inflammatory, threatening, disrespectful, or sexually explicit language;
 - c. materials that use language or images that are inappropriate in the education setting or disruptive to the educational process;
 - d. information or materials that could cause damage or danger of disruption to the educational process;
 - e. materials that use language or images that advocate violence or discrimination toward other people (hate literature) or that may constitute harassment or discrimination.
2. Students will not use the Groves system to knowingly or recklessly post, transmit or distribute false or defamatory information about a person or organization, to harass another person, or to engage in personal attacks, including prejudicial or discriminatory attacks.
3. Students will not use the Groves system to engage in any illegal act or violate any local, state or federal law.
4. Students will not use the Groves system to vandalize, damage or disable the property of another person or organization, will not make deliberate attempts to degrade or disrupt equipment, software or system performance by spreading computer viruses or by any other means, will not tamper with, modify or change the Groves system software, hardware or wiring or take any action to violate the school's security system, and will not use the school's system in such a way to disrupt the use of the system by other users.
5. Students will not use the Groves system to gain unauthorized access to information resources or to access another person's materials, information or files without the implied or direct permission of that person.
6. Students will not use the Groves system to post private information about another person, personal contact information about themselves or other persons, or other personally identifiable information, including but not limited to, address, telephone numbers, school addresses, work addresses, identification numbers, account names, access codes or passwords, labeled photographs, social security numbers or other information that would make the individual's identity easily traceable, and will not repost a message that was sent to the user privately without permission of the person who sent the message.
7. Students will not attempt to gain unauthorized access to the school's system or any other system through the school's system, attempt to log in through another person's account, or use computer accounts, access codes or

network identification other than those assigned to the student. Users are expected to keep their passwords private.

8. Users will not use the Groves system to violate copyright laws or usage licensing agreements, or otherwise to use another person's property without the person's prior approval or proper citation, including the downloading or exchanging of pirated software or copying software to or from any school computer, and will not plagiarize works they find on the internet.
- B. If a student inadvertently accesses unacceptable materials or an unacceptable internet site, the user shall immediately disclose the inadvertent access to an appropriate school official. This disclosure may serve as a defense against an allegation that the student has intentionally violated this policy. In certain rare instances, a student may access otherwise unacceptable materials if necessary to complete an assignment and if done with the prior approval of and with the appropriate guidance from the appropriate teacher.

VI. Filter

- A. With respect to any of its computers with internet access, Groves will monitor the online activities of the students and employ technology protection measures during any use of such computers by minors and adults. The technology protection measures utilized will block or filter internet access to any websites that are:
1. Obscene;
 2. Pornographic;
 3. Promoting Alcohol, Tobacco, Gambling, Violence, Crime or illegal activity;
 4. Tasteless or Offensive;
 5. Advertisement;
 6. Peer to Peer;
 7. Spam;
 8. Chat;
 9. Personals + Dating;
 10. Deemed inappropriate for students by Groves' administrators, teachers or tech staff.
- B. Tech staff can disable the filter, during use by a student, to enable access for bona fide research or other lawful purposes.
