

## Upper School Supply List 2010/2011

### Multi-class items

- Homework binder – Recommended: “Mead Five-Star, First Gear Binder 1½ inch” or larger or “American Studio Zipper Binder 1½ inch” or larger. They both have zip close, preventing loss of materials. **This binder will be carried from class-to-class.**
- Pencil Case – “Mead Five-Star Zipper Pouch” is constructed well, has compartments for computer materials, and snaps into a 3-ring binder.
- Pencils – 4 boxes of #2 pencils. If student prefers mechanical pencils, please provide at least 2 boxes of regular, #2 pencils.
- Pens – 1-2 boxes of black or blue ballpoint pens. Also several red pens.
- Erasers – at least 1 big eraser.
- Binders
  - 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade: Six 3-ring, 1½-inch binders with pockets on the inside of cover and the plastic view sheet on the outside that allows covers to be inserted on the binder. **These are classroom binders to be left in class.**
  - 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade: Four 3-ring, 1½-inch binders with pockets on the inside of cover and the plastic view sheet on the outside that allows covers to be inserted on the binder. **These are classroom binders to be left in class.**
- 8 sets of tabbed paper or plastic dividers – these are for making different sections in the plastic 3-ring binder. (Two sets for math and science.)
- 6 full-sized boxes of tissue
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
- Colored pencils

### Reading/Writing Classes

- Three packs of 100 white lined note cards
- Pack of 4 highlighters

### Science Class (9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade)

- 1 ruler with metric units
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 1 pair of adult size scissors
- One black Sharpie

### Ecology (11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade)

- Scientific calculator (can be the same as using for math classes)
- Sketchbook with heavy weight paper (for water color washes)

- Drawing pencils (any pencil will do but recommend a 2B, HB, and 2H)
- Pocket pencil sharpener
- Pencil pouch big enough for the sketch pad and pencils
- Kneaded eraser
- White rubber eraser

### **Chemistry (11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade)**

- Scientific calculator (can be the same as using for math classes)

### **Math**

- One package of sheet protectors
- One package of graph paper (for all geometry students)
- 2 packages of loose leaf paper (no spiral notebook paper, please)
- Calculators:
  - Applied Math, Geometry Concepts, and Consumer Math students—TI-30X calculator from Texas Instruments (or equivalent scientific calculator)
  - Pre-Algebra and Pre-Algebra Readiness students—solar calculator with only simple functions (+, −, ×, ÷, square root key)
  - Formal Geometry, Algebra 1, and Algebra 2 students—TI-83 Plus **or** TI-84 Plus Graphing Calculator  
(**note:** TI-82, TI-89, and TI-90 series **are not** useable for these classes as they don't have the functions that students need)
